A [Regional Workshop on the ASEAN Roadmap for the Attainment of the MDGs](#) took place on 24-25 January 2011 in Bangkok. Results include concrete steps to revitalize the draft ASEAN MDG Roadmap as well as to improve reporting and monitoring on MDG progress. The MDG Acceleration Framework proposed by UNDP was very well received by the ASEAN delegates. The APRC led the UN-interagency collaboration with valuable contributions from UNESCAP, UN Women, UNFPA, UNICEF, UNAIDS, FAO, WFP, WHO,

UNIDO and UN Millennium Campaign. The workshop received extensive support from cross-practice engagements of our teams: Poverty Reduction, Energy & Environment, Governance, HIV and Health as well as UNDP Country office colleagues in ASEAN countries.

APRC hosted the *11th Regional Thematic Working Meeting on MDG 1*. A key outcome was an inter-agency decision to prepare an Asia-Pacific Regional Roadmap for accelerating progress on MDG 1 (2011-2015) in the *Delivering as One* framework. It was also agreed that UNDP APRC would coordinate the preparation of advocacy briefs and case stories on themes of critical importance within MDG 1. The meeting on January 27 brought together senior officials from UN agencies - ESCAP, FAO, WFP, ILO, UNICEF, UNFPA and bilateral partners, such as EU and USAID.

Strategic Engagement Policy 2011

APRC kicked off the annual series of discussions on the 2011 Engagement plans with the 24 Country offices in the region. Country priorities, key deliverables and areas of expected support from the APRC were discussed during the teleconference on January 28th with the Country office in Nepal. The video and audio teleconferences with COs will be convened throughout the month of February.

Knowledge sharing

At their first for 2011 *Knowledge Management monthly meeting* on January 26th Practice Leaders agreed to establish a robust coordination in order to better market intelligence, partnerships and impact. The Knowledge Sharing Team presented a pilot version of a [Knowledge Dashboard](#) for a consolidated planning and monitoring of [Knowledge products](#), Missions and Regional Events.
